# What Are We Asking?

An operational referendum asks voters for authorization to exceed the state imposed revenue limit for day-to-day operational expenses. It's called operational because if approved, the district will receive additional funding from the tax levy to operate our schools.

The state revenue limit is a cap on the total overall revenue from the combined amount of tax revenue and state aid that a school district can receive in a year. An operational referendum seeks voter approval on a levy override to provide funds for the day-to-day school operational budget.


### **Our Mission & Vision**
